





CCR is operated by the California Department of Public Health and ten regional cancer registries, is an essential tool for the prevention and control of cancer in California.



- Can discuss neighborhood cancer occurrence with anyone, including the South Bay cities.
- Knows of no evidence that there is an increase in cancer occurrence there, but cannot be helpful unless he knows what makes "many" concerned.
- Most variations in cancer rates in such localities are the result of demographic rather than true geographic (i.e. local exposure) differences, due to differences in age, race, education and income.
- Cannot be more specific without more information.
